



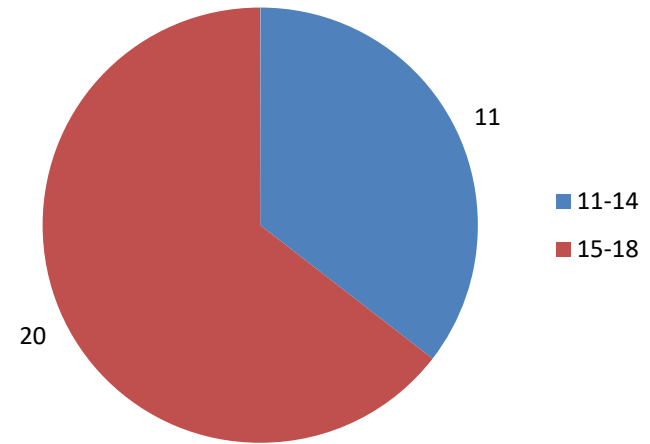
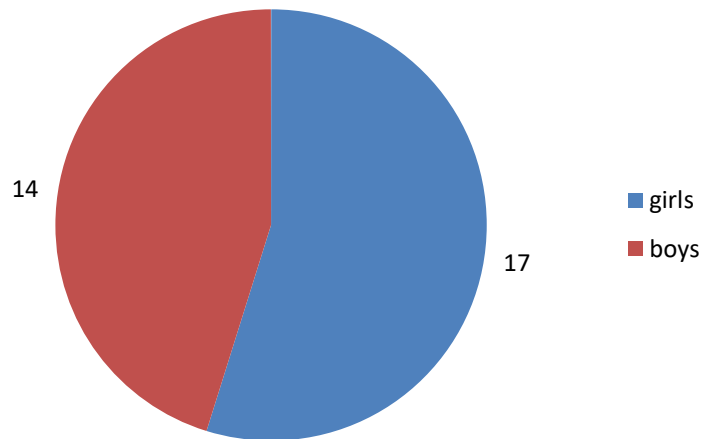

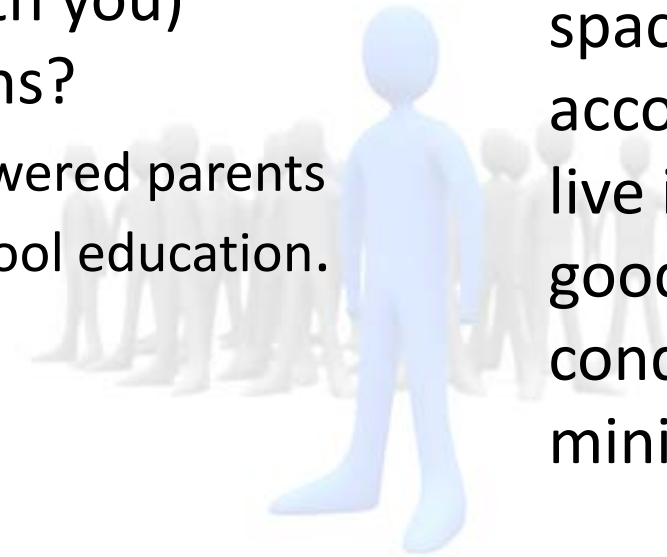
- Parents' professional situation?

- Parents' (or the person who live with you) qualifications?

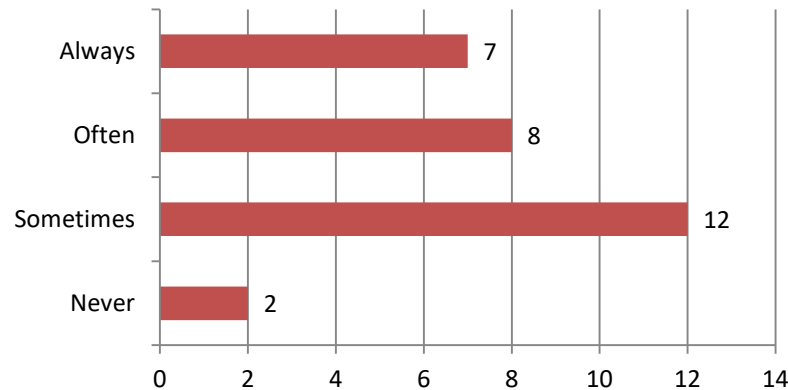
22 students answered parents have high school education.

- 18 say they live in a spacious and comfortable accommodation, and 8 live in a modest house in good conservation condition, with a minimum of comfort.

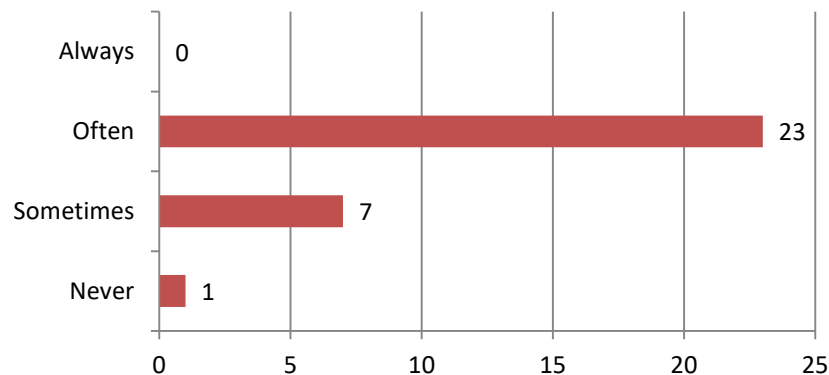


SOCIAL EXCLUSION

12 students said SOMETIMES/19 said NEVER.

In your opinion, are the best students at school better treated by their classmates (eg, invitation to a birthday party or to go to their house)?

12 students said SOMETIMES/ 17 said NEVER.

In your opinion, are the students with the worst grades at school, better treated by their classmates (eg, invitation to a birthday party or to go to their house)?

13 students said SOMETIMES/18 said NEVER.

In the breaks, do you feel that others exclude you?

5 students said SOMETIMES/26 said NEVER.

If you answered "sometimes" or "always", why do you think that happens?

3 students answered: "I do not have the same interests".
