- * “***A week without bullying***” is an annual event in our school organized by a national organization “Children’s Help Line”

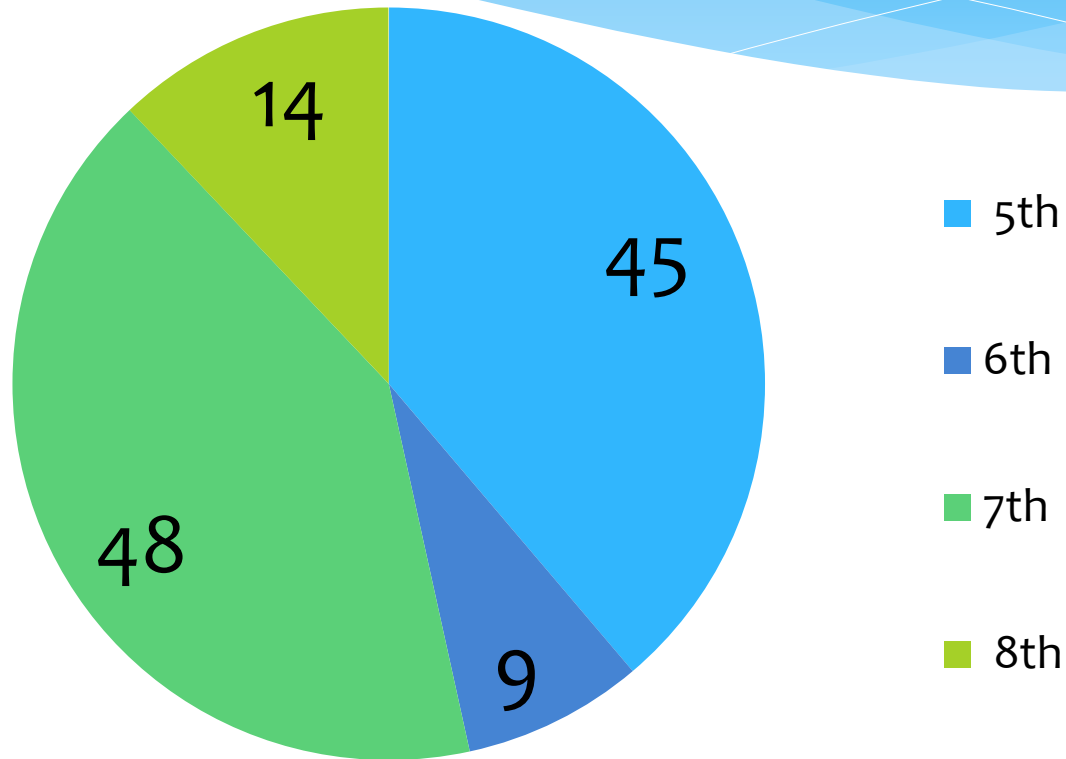

Statistic of respondents:

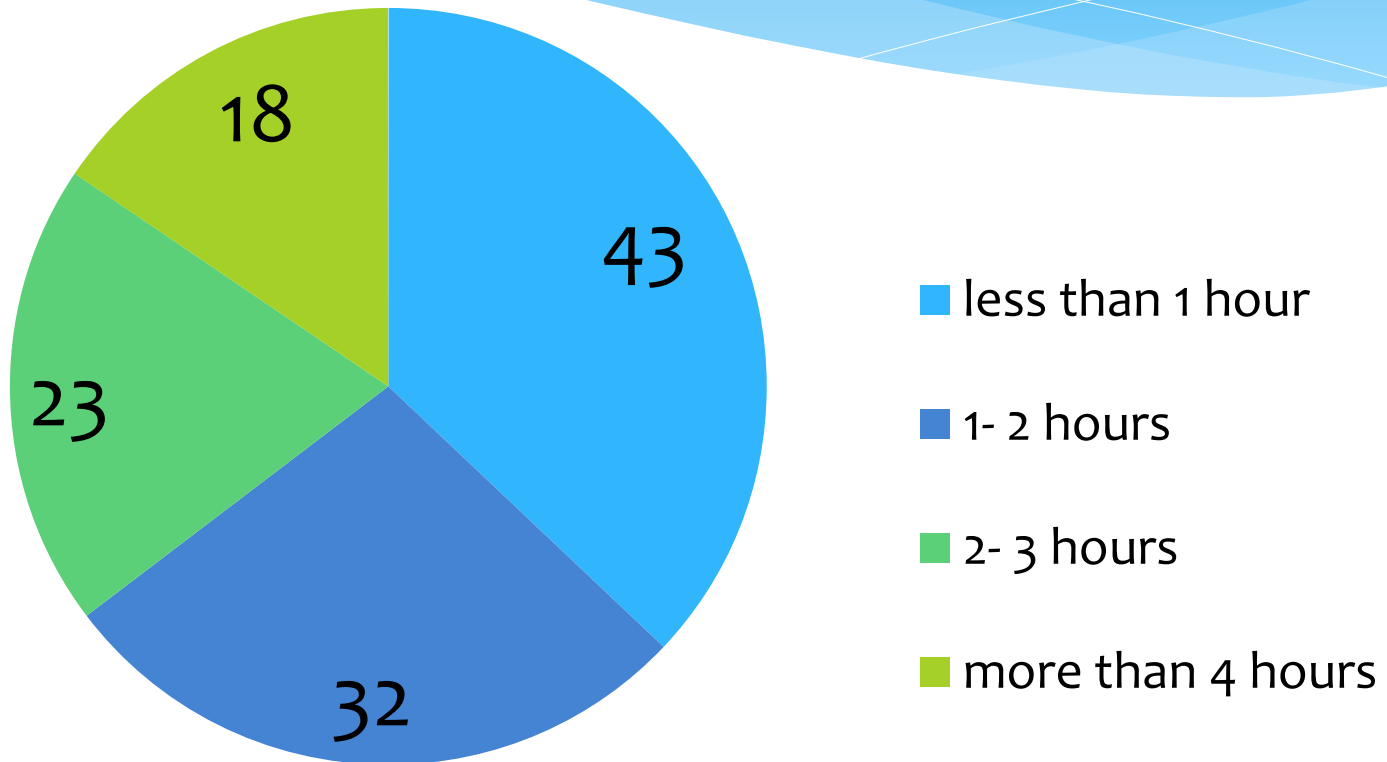


- ❖ Number of respondents- 116

- ❖ Average age- 12.5 year

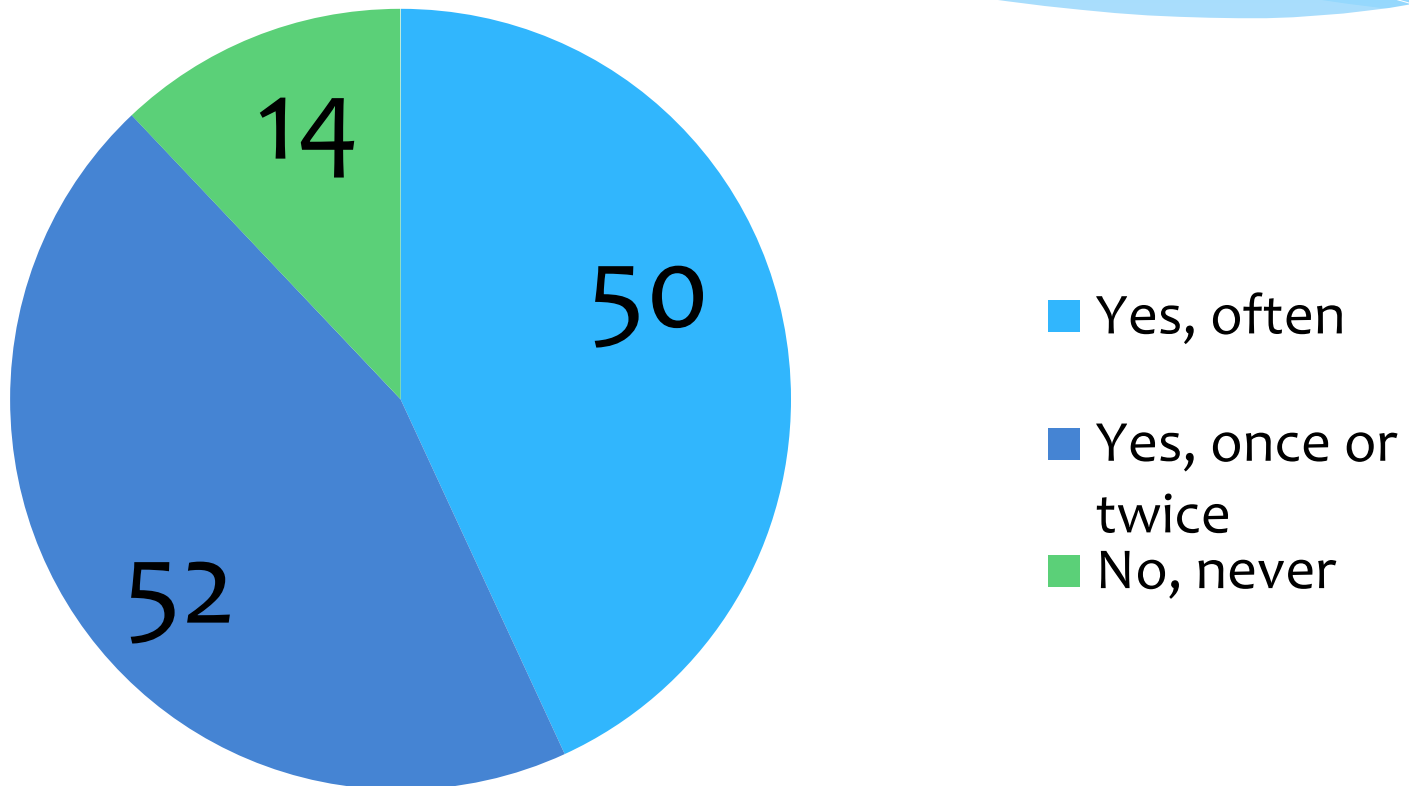
Which class are you in?



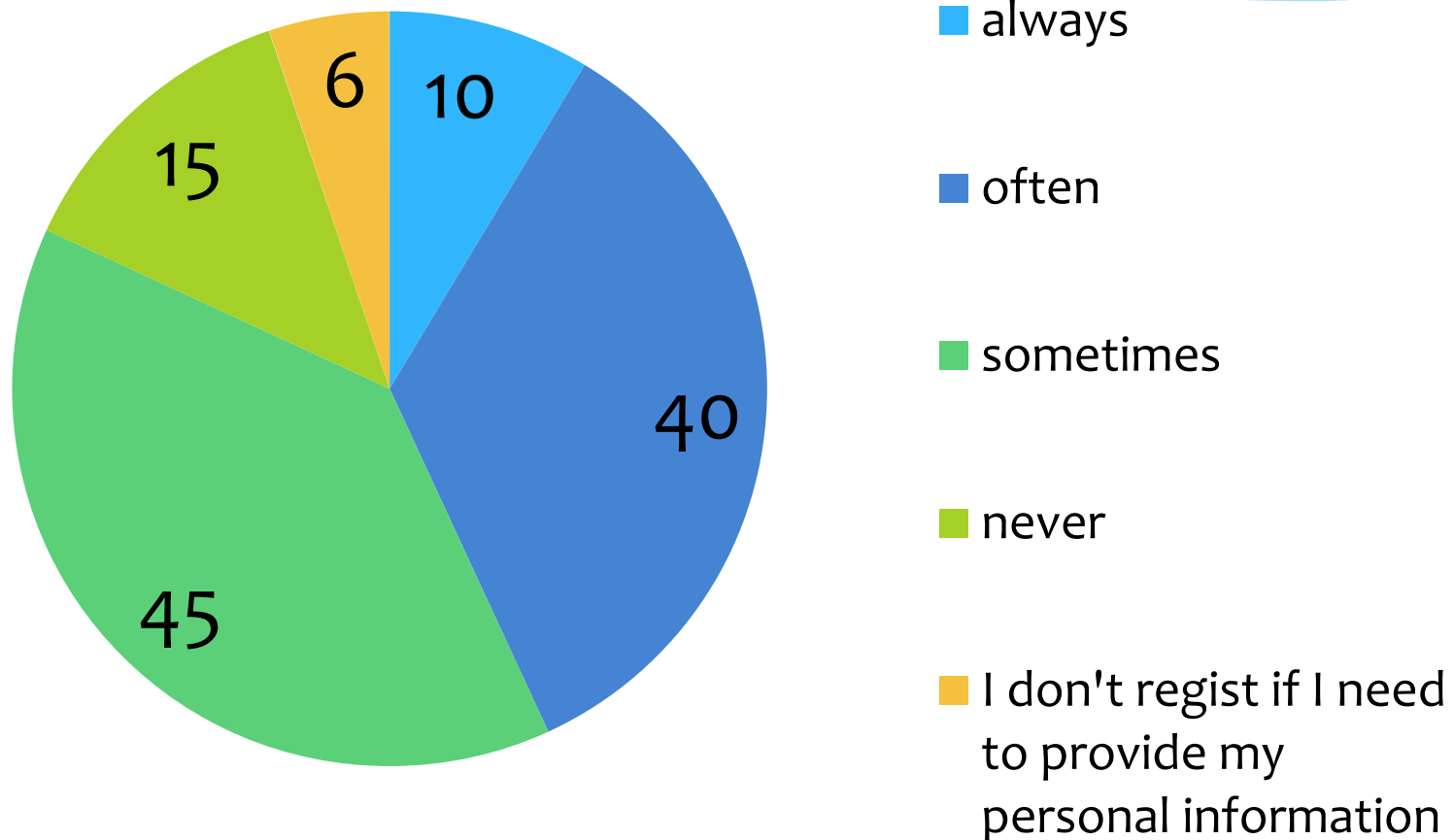
How much time do you spend per day on your computer?



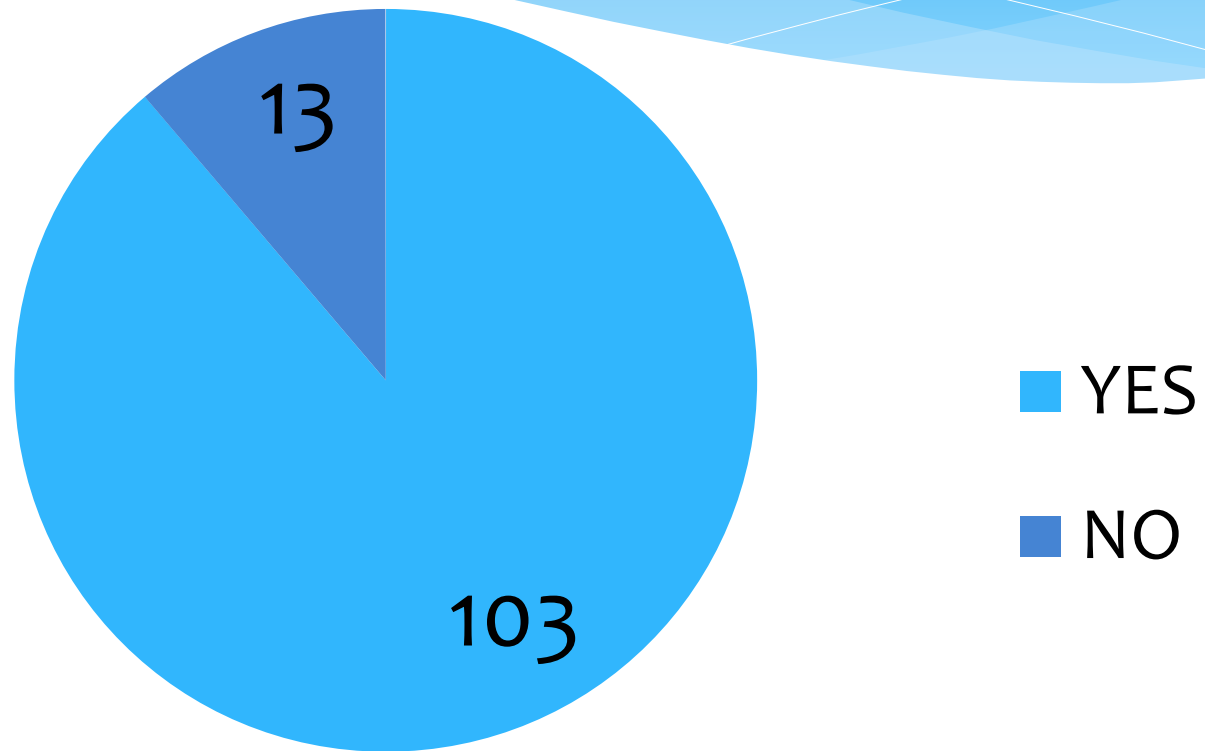
**Do your parents speak / advise /

safely online?**



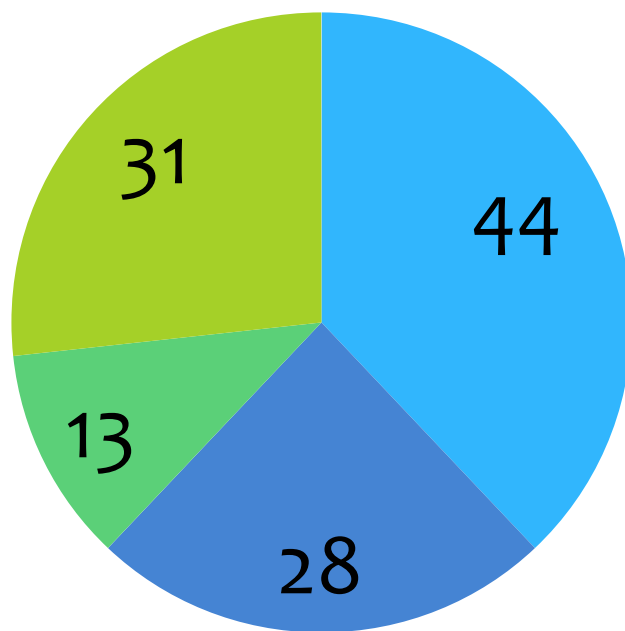
Are you providing your real personal information -name, surname, year of birth, when you sign in on various websites?



Do you have a Facebook account?

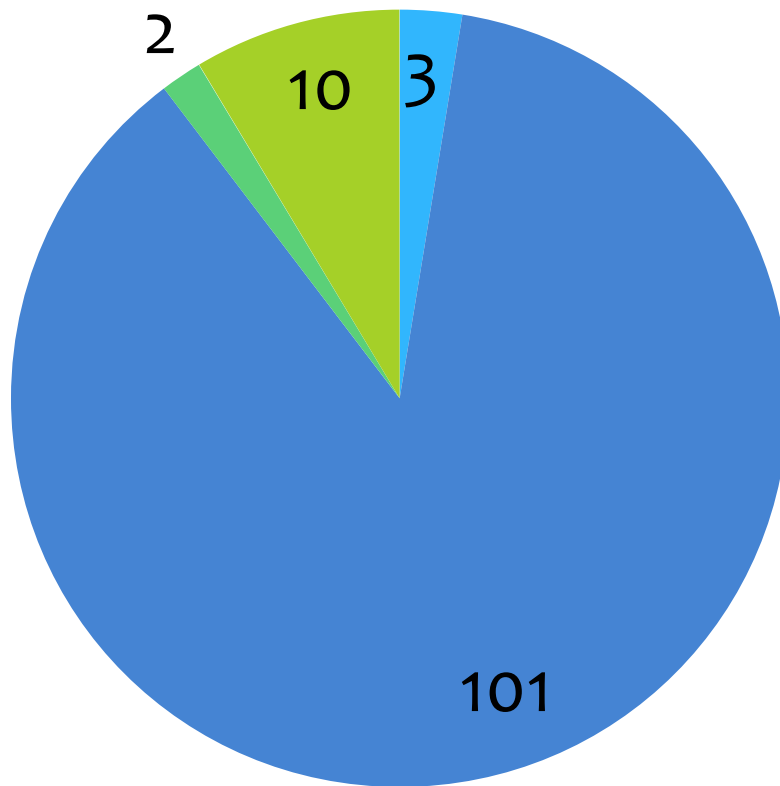


How often do you use social networks, dating sites?



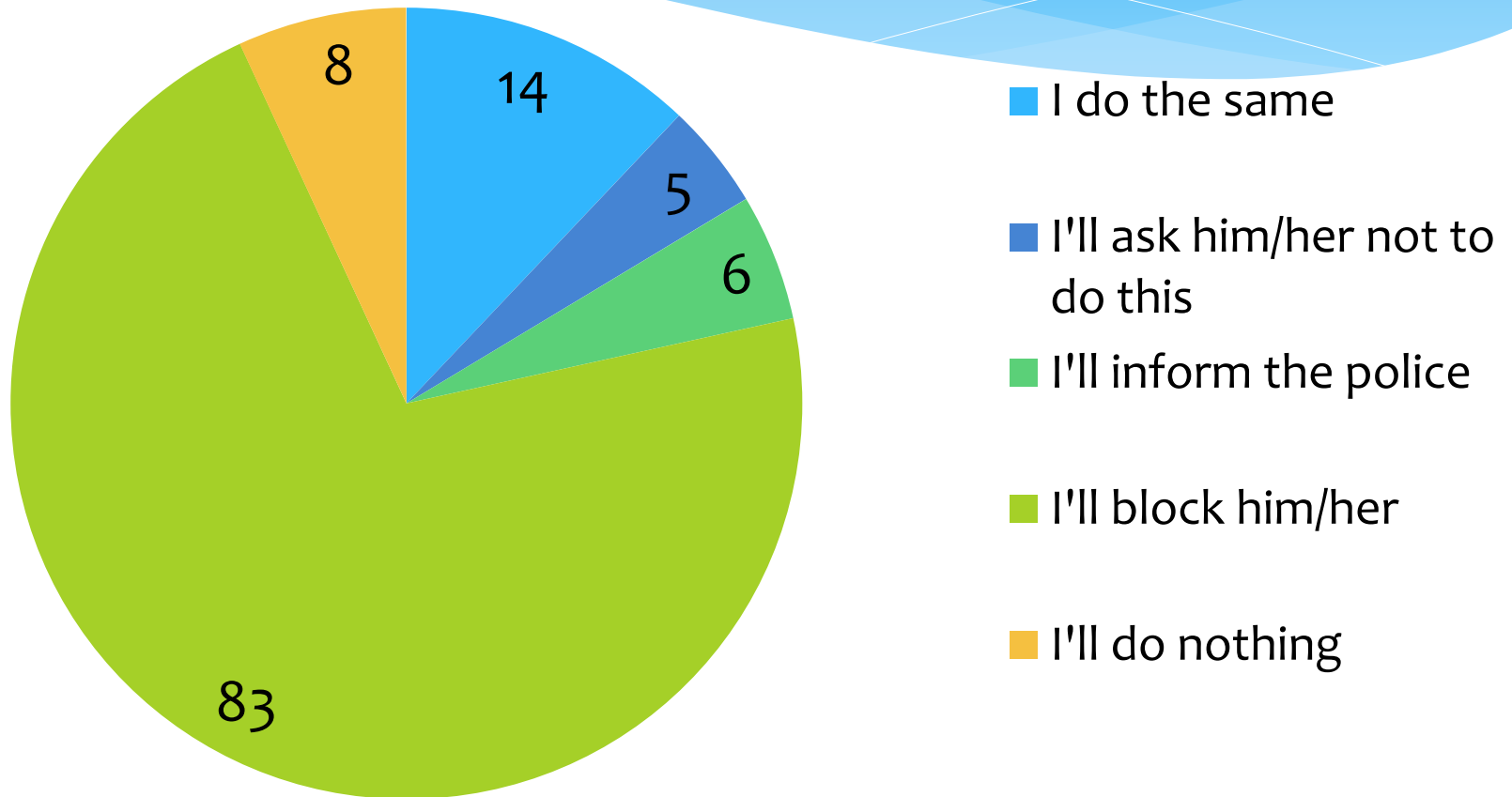
- Every day

A new friend from a social network invites you to meet and asks you not to mention anything about this meeting to your parents. How will you behave?

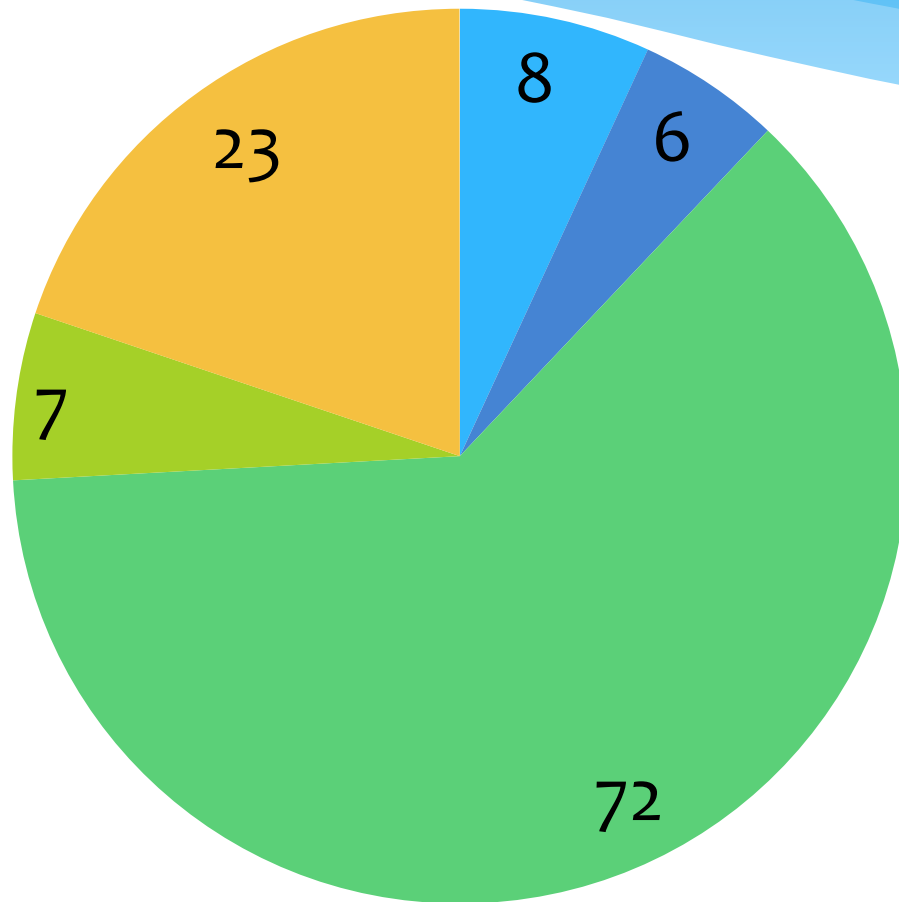


- Of course, I listen to him/her and do not tell my parents

On the internet, one person writes unpleasant comments to you, sends messages. How will you behave?

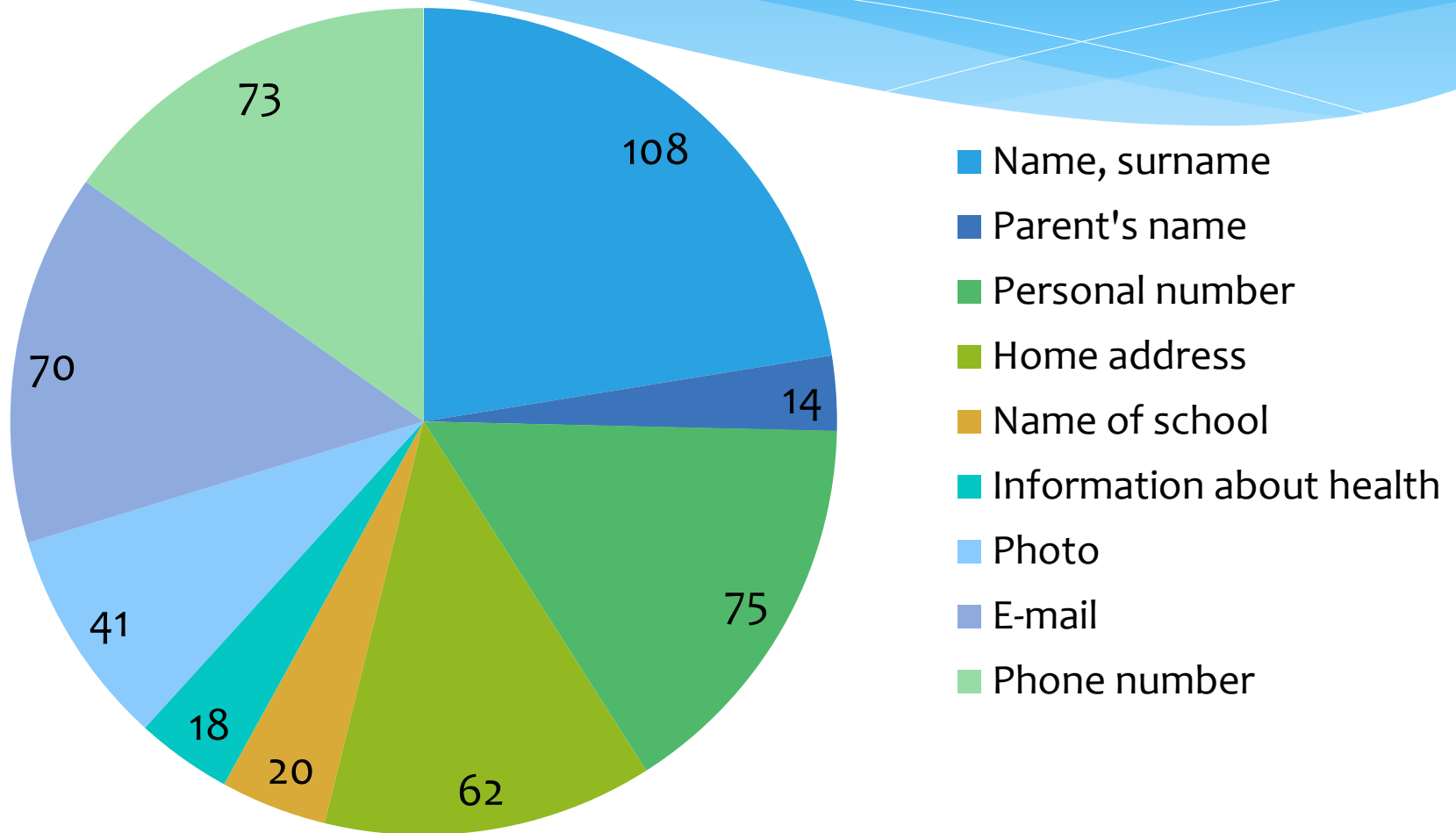


What kind of photos or videos can you post on Facebook or another social network?

A cyber Bullying situation (January- June, 2017)

- * The 6th grade educator received information about cyber bullying situation in her class during Christmas holidays.
- * It turned out that one girl from Instagram had uploaded another girl's photo to a closed group on Facebook.
- * Abusive comments started in that closed group.
- * The group's members, who were also classmates, mocked her.

Solutions/strategies:

- * A cooperation agreement was signed on improving the classroom microclimate and providing psychological security;
- * Parents have been re-introduced to steps for the safer use of the Internet;
- * Parents were reminded about the responsibility of the behavior of their juvenile children on the Internet;
- * The students once again were introduced to the *Code of Good Behavior Online*;

- 
- * Psychological help was offered to the pupils and their parents;
 - * A social pedagogue, a psychologist together with a class leader, constantly monitors pupils' relationships and carry out individual conversations;
 - * Pupils have been penalized for the Olweus Bullying Prevention Program at the Gymnasium.
